



Thai Baht Remains Strong

The Bank of Thailand revealed that since the beginning of the year, fluctuation of the Thai Baht increased from 3.2% to 4.8%. In the meantime, in Malaysia, the flux went from 9% to 13% and Singapore dollars' from 5.1% to 8.7%. Due to the growing currency rate in the South-East Asian region, Thailand remains in a stable position at this stage in terms of the currency exchange rate.

Thai Baht has remained stronger by approximately 1 % in comparison to US dollars. The Bank of Thailand confirmed that there is still no policy for the fund measurement to be recognised in this situation.
